**ATR VERDICT:** All eyes will be on TOAST OF NEW YORK, who has been brought out of retirement and put back in training with Jamie Osborne. The 2014 UAE Derby winner has been absent since finishing second to Bayern in the 2014 Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita, he was bought by current connections after that near-miss and was originally sent to stud after he suffered a tendon injury. A market check is strongly advised to ascertain the level of confidence behind his chances. Petite Jack is fitted with first-time blinkers here but is unlikely to get the strong pace to chase that he craves. Intern has been absent since finishing down the field at Ascot in the summer, so perhaps the main danger may be 102-rated three-year-old Mr Scaramanga, who has the assistance of course specialist Adam Kirby in the saddle.
