ATR VERDICT: MONSIEUR BAY ran more than respectably when fourth to Al Kout on his debut last month at Wolverhampton and the son of Sir Percy is expected to take a step forward from that debut effort. Dash Of Spice was runner-up when last seen at Epsom and looks a player on that form, while Past Master had some very good form as a two-year-old, including when placed behind Group 1 placed Stormy Antarctic, and it seems notable that Henry Candy has persisted with the son of Mastercraftsman.
