ATR VERDICT: REDICEAN was impressive when opening his account over hurdles in style over course and distance last time and Alan King's 85,000 guineas juvenile should be capable of repeating that effort here against tougher opposition. The challenge is led by Vaziani who himself scored by nine-lengths on his hurdles bow, with handler Robert Walford operating at 25 per cent of late. Kempton should suit Kapdad much more than Newbury did and he is a potential improver to note, while hurdles newcomer Ray's The Money was a handy performer on the Flat.
