ATR VERDICT: Royal Magic could put his rivals under pressure if he jumps well from the front but now he's upped in trip and carrying a penalty, he might give way to SECRET INVESTOR late on. Paul Nicholls' charge found 2m5f too sharp on his seasonal bow here in November but he's a 3m point winner and is expected to go one better now granted a stiffer test. Both Duke Debarry and Chef Des Obeaux are potential improvers too now stepped up in trip and also merit inclusion on the shortlist.
