







ATR VERDICT: Fountains Windfall sets the standard here, though he is likely to be short enough in the betting despite successive tumbles and could be worth opposing. The Young Master is likely to have bigger targets on his agenda later in the spring, while On Tour has a point to prove. It could be worth chancing 11-year-old BALLYALTON, who has gone well in two recent Cheltenham handicaps and he should be suited by this step up in trip. Ballykan is on a fair mark and could prove the main danger.
