






ATR VERDICT: AZZURI has the best form on offer in this contest and has been found a winnable opening by Dan Skelton. A disappointing beaten favourite in novice company at Worcester when last seen in September, the six-year-old is likely to have benefitted from a break and can bounce back here. Vivaccio ran well on his first outing since March 2016 last time out and will relish the likely testing ground, while Red Riverman looks fairly handicapped and was unlucky to bump into a well-treated winner at Newbury 24 days ago.
