ATR VERDICT: This is not a vintage renewal of this Grade 3 contest and Missed Approach is bound to be popular given his finishing position in the Ladbrokes Trophy last time out. That form has not worked out particularly well but he did finish second in the National Hunt Chase last March. COGRY has certainly improved his jumping technique in the last 12 months or so and he was only beaten a neck in the Scottish National last April. He is now just 7lb higher in the ratings, which is slightly surprising given that he won by four lengths in a valuable handicap at Cheltenham in October. Sir Mangan is another with strong form claims based on his victory at Bangor last time out, while Cresswell Breeze and Russe Blanc have each-way claims.
