


Allonok represents powerful connections and is likely to go close, while Thebannerkingrebel and Brigadier Bob are others to keep an eye on. Baby Ted is a half-brother to dual Grade 2 winner Colin's Sister and is sure to know his job, but slight preference is for stablemate MIDNIGHT TROUBLE. He is also bred to have plenty of ability, being a full-brother to five-time winner Midnight Request, and jockey bookings would arguably point in his favour.
