That said, the nine-year-old bounced back to form at the same venue when only beaten a nose over 2m4f there last month. Based on that evidence he could take plenty of beating today despite a 4lb rise in the ratings. Ramonex and Takingrisks are other in-form participants to note, while Caraline cannot be discounted.
