ATR VERDICT: OUR LUCAS took a big step forward when finishing second over C&D last month and a 1lb drop in the ratings for that effort appears to be very fair. It should be noted that it was just his second start for this yard and he may have more improvement left in him. Bering Upsun can go well if he bounces back to the form which saw him make the frame at Carlisle in November, while Bill D'aron and The Lady Rules also warrant consideration.
