However, an 8lb rise for that 65-length victory is at least sensible, and if he can get into a good rhythm on the front end again, a double is still a possibility. Born To Size won at Thurles in October on his final start for previous connections and merits a market check, while recent Chepstow runner-up Looks Like Power wouldn't be winning out of turn either.
