ATR VERDICT: Kimberlite Candy finally put it together over fences when winning a novice handicap at Market Rasen on Boxing Day and appeals as the type to improve for stepping up in distance. You Say What was disappointing on his latest start at Exeter but had been progressive before that and can easily land a blow here. Two Smokin Barrels still looks feasibly handicapped on the pick of his form but the vote goes to MILLANISI BOY as he improved plenty for the application of cheekpieces and more forceful tactics when winning at Chepstow last month. A repeat of those tactics could see a 3lb rise in the weights prove fairly lenient.
