ATR VERDICT: KNIGHTHOOD wouldn't have the typical National Hunt pedigree coming out of a Group 2-placed mare on the Flat in Italy but there is the potential that he could have too much speed for his rivals on his racecourse debut. It also looks notable that his trainer sends him for his racecourse debut here with the yard tending to send some of their better bumper horses to the Berkshire venue. Up To No Good is a half-brother to the stable's Grade 2 winner Keeper Hill and has Richard Johnson in the saddle, while Coole Well comes from a solid family and is respected on debut for Ben Pauling.
