**ATR VERDICT:** Nicky Henderson saddles two interesting five-year-olds here in Darius Des Bois and No Hiding Place with the latter potentially best placed to take this and he is the mount of Nico De Boinville. Donald McCain is another handler with two charges and both Spin The Coin and Ofcourseiwill can go well at long odds. However, preference is for JERSEY BEAN who was blindsided at the first when unseating last time and can go well here with a repeat of his Ascot bumper win back in the Autumn. Luckime has been well held so far but has plenty of potential for when the penny finally drops, while Richard Mitford-Slade has been making a name for himself in his opening season training and despite his point-to-point/hunter chase form not looking the most convincing, it would be foolish to rule out his Master Tradesman.
