ATR VERDICT: A Toi Phil seldom runs a bad race and sets the standard with his rating of 155, but preference is for the less exposed AMERICAN TOM. The American Post gelding has always been held in high regard by Willie Mullins' camp and returned from a 10-month absence to run a mighty race in Grade 3 company at Naas in November, only giving way late on. He is entitled to be a lot sharper today and can hopefully now start to fulfil his promise. Woodland Opera probably prefers better ground but does have a big engine, while Nambour and Arctic Skipper may both need the run.
