ATR VERDICT: GILGAMBOA was fourth in the 2016 Grand National and doesn't have that many miles on the clock relative to an average 10-year-old chaser. This is only his 19th career start and he's expected to follow up his recent 2m6f victory at Down Royal over Venitien De Mai to notch a double. C&D winner Foxrock had won four hunter chases in a row before pulling up in the Irish Grand National last season and is considered the main danger to the selection.
