ATR VERDICT: Paddyplex takes a big drop in class after an admirable second here last time out and looks to get this trip well, while Lexington Law isn't the easiest of rides but seemed suited by first-time cheekpieces back on the Flat when winning at Lingfield in December. Theglasgowwarrior looks progressive but this can go the way of new David O'Meara recruit STONIFIC. A useful type in France for Andre Fabre, this yard often thrives with such types and an opening UK handicap mark of 79 looks there to be taken advantage of.
