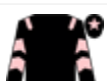

ATR VERDICT: SHOCKINGTIMES is hardly the most reliable horse you will find, though, a repeat of his Leicester second off the same handicap mark should see him hard to beat here for Jamie Snowden and Brendan Powell. Redmond was a clear second best to a progressive chaser on his stable debut for Jack Barber but could be capable of plenty more now, while the likeable veteran Turban and Neil Mulholland's consistent Matrow's Lady are others holding claims.
