ATR VERDICT: LOST AT SEA went down by a head over track and trip when last sighted and should remain competitive following a 3lb rise, so is considered the most likely winner. Ifubelieveindreams showed this mark isn't beyond her when beaten by under a length at Lingfield in November and could be tough to keep out of the frame. It will be interesting to see if a drop in grade can revitalise Glory Awaits, who held his own off higher marks in stronger races on turf last summer.
