






ATR VERDICT: Eastlake has had a wind operation but is likely to be using this to prepare for bigger targets in the spring, while Baby King rates as an intriguing contender after his second in the Scottish Champion Chase at Musselburgh earlier this month. He could be the one to side with at the likely prices.
