**ATR VERDICT:** Michael Appleby has two solid chances with Epitaph, who seldom runs a bad race at this venue, and recent C&D selling winner The Lock Master, while Busy Street warrants respect despite the 198-day absence. The vote, however, goes to ACKER BILK, who has done little wrong in three starts so far this year, is least exposed with only seven runs under his belt and could potentially improve for the application of first-time cheekpieces.
