ATR VERDICT: SILVER KAYF built on his victory at Huntingdon over the extended 2m3f when finishing a creditable third over 2m4f under a penalty at Southwell last time and is considered the safest option. Although penalised for winning at Market Rasen in November, Dans Le Vent is also expected to finish on the premises. If the aforementioned pair prove vulnerable under their penalties, Stage Summit, a bumper winner having his third run over timber, and point scorer Ballymillen, who debuts under Rules, could take a hand.
