**ATR VERDICT:** Brendan Powell holds a strong hand here with both Spiritofedinburgh and Hold Hands having more than solid claims, while Oregon Gift (was also engaged to run at Wolverhampton on Thursday) has run well on his first two outings for Charlie Mann and should go well once again. Bird For Life shouldn't be ruled out for Mark Usher and has gone well over the track and trip of late, but preference is for WALLY'S WISDOM, who scored well over course and distance last time and a mere 3lb rise gives John Jenkins' gelding the chance to follow up here.
