ATR VERDICT: Recent Southwell scorer Illusional warrants plenty of respect while Holy Tiber is worth a market check at least ahead of her first outing since October. Carp Kid is a past C&D scorer and has been knocking on the door recently, but preference is for Sir Mark Prescott's handicap debutant HARMONICA. The Pivotal filly shaped with plenty of promise in three starts last year and looks potentially a fair bit better than this opening mark of 73. She gets in off a nice weight after Gavin Ashton's claim.
