












ATR VERDICT: This is not the strongest of races but it makes it an ideal opportunity for SO SATISFIED to return to winning ways after his disappointing effort at Musselburgh last time out. The son of Aqlaam had won at Catterick two starts ago and it is far too soon to be writing him off. Dun Faw Good opened his account under Rules when last seen and another good run can be expected from the veteran, although a 7lb rise will make life tougher. Tikkandemickey and Log On have valid each-way claims.
