ATR VERDICT: Aidan O'Brien unleashes three extremely well-bred fillies who all displayed some sort of promise at juveniles and they should all improve this year. The pick of his trio is BROADWAY, a Galileo half-sister to Danedream, who finished fourth on her debut over 6f at Naas last June. That trip was never going to suit this filly and she has a much stronger chance this afternoon. Magic Wand was well beaten over 1m here in October and this half-sister to Chicquita should only improve for that experience, while Athena appears to be the third string. Claiomh Geal, Jaega and Shannow are newcomers who warrant consideration.
