ATR VERDICT: GARDENS OF BABYLON outran odds of 20/1 to finish third on his debut over 1m here in October and the second from that race was only beaten a neck at Naas on Friday. The son of Camelot is entitled to improve as a three-year-old and a first-time tongue-tie may bring about further improvement in him. Change Of Velocity finished fifth in a maiden here last July that has worked out extremely well and he could pose the biggest threat to the selection. Sir Erec has a similar profile to his stablemate but his form is not quite as strong. while any market support for Khalaab would have to be noted.
