ATR VERDICT: SHANKLYS DAWN needed every yard of the extended 2m3f when scoring at Downpatrick, suggesting that this longer trip will be more of a help than a hindrance, and she gets the vote to follow up off 4lb higher. Highest Benefit was narrowly beaten at Clonmel and should go close again, while Swift could potentially improve for first-time cheekpieces.
