ATR VERDICT: Willie Mullins holds a strong hand here saddling four with leading claims, three of which carry the colours of Sullivan Bloodstock, with preference for the impressive Gowran winner SAGLAWY. The Youmzain gelding thrived in the mud that day when 15 lengths clear of a handy yardstick in Icaro (has since won at Down Royal), and he is expected to flourish in similar forecast conditions here. The Rich Ricci-owned Saldier somewhat let down his lofty reputation in the Triumph Hurdle when only fifth but has to be respected here, while Gordon Elliott's dual C&D winner Mitchouka and Fred Winter winner Veneer Of Charm make this a Grade Two contest with plenty of depth.
