ATR VERDICT: Gordon Elliott is double-handed at the top of the weights here with Monkshood, who should find this easier than the Graded contests he's been running in lately, and the highly-regarded Poli Roi who can get his season back on track upped in trip having been crying out for a staying test on his outings so far. Gigginstown, who are responsible for of the aforementioned pair, also have Mortal running in their colours. Joseph O'Brien's gelding has knocked on the door the last twice and is another who should benefit for today's stamina challenge. That handler also saddles Speak Easy, who was a beaten favourite in Grade Two company last time and must be respected with Barry Geraghty in the plate, while Massey's Wood was strong at the finish when scoring at the distance at Thurles and is another who must be considered. However, the way CASTAFIORE PARK won at Limerick last time hinted that there would be definitely be more to come when upped in trip once again and she could be thrown in at the ratings on her handicap bow, having only been beaten by useful mares over inadequate trips so far this term.
