ATR VERDICT: SIZING COAL produced a nice performance to land the odds with ease over an extended 2m5f here last time out and could excel in this sphere. Jaimie Codd gets the leg up and with the return to a longer trip no concern, Jim Dreaper's charge could take some beating. His stablemate Venitien De Mai is respected but a bigger threat may be Fenno's Storm, who beat that rival by half a length when landing a similar event at Gowran last month and is relatively unexposed.
