TIMEFORM VIEW: Andre Fabre's trips across the Channel are usually well-judged and LE BRIVIDO should prove hard to beat if ready to roll following a 10-month layoff. He probably had more in hand than the winning margin suggests when touching off Spirit of Valor at Royal Ascot last summer and dropping back in trip shouldn't be an issue. Brando is an obvious danger, while Dream of Dreams also merits respect.
