**ATR VERDICT:** A competitive heat in which none of the runners can be ruled out. A chance is taken on COPAIN DE CLASSE leaving behind his latest effort at Kempton now fitted with a first-time tongue-tie. He ran well enough off this mark when third in an Ascot handicap in November. The drop back from 2m5f appears ideal for Valhalla while Azzuri, a dual winner over an extended 1m7f at Southwell last summer, would be a big player on decent ground.
