A chance, however, is taken on newcomer SHATHARAAT for Mark Johnston and Sheikh Hamdan. The Kodiak colt has plenty of dash in his pedigree as a half-brother to dual Pattern-race winner Nations Alexander, and can get off the mark at the first time of asking. Super D J was not knocked about when his chance had gone on his debut at Kempton and completes the shortlist.
