**ATR VERDICT:** It's O Kay looks to be the best of the two Olly Murphy runners over Foxtrot Juliet based on jockey bookings and should go well, although it is a concern that she seemingly refused to go through with her winning effort when holding every chance at Wetherby last time out. It might be worth taking a punt on the Irish raider, DOLLYS DESTINATION, who has some nice form in the book behind the likes of Felix Desjy and Lucca Lady. Cheltenham Festival-winning rider Noel McParlan takes the ride and a big run looks likely.
