ATR VERDICT: Plenty of these have valid claims but there is no standout candidate, although the marginal preference is for NASSYA. The daughter of Dubawi displayed some promising signs when finishing fifth on her debut at Doncaster last October and her pedigree suggests that she should improve as a three-year-old. Sun Maiden did not live up to her breeding, being a Frankel half-sister to Middy, when finishing fourth on her debut in December but it is far too soon to be writing her off. Others to note are Sheila's Rock, Voluminous, Whispering Sands and White Light.
