







**ATR VERDICT:** Coronet very much sets the standard having run well in multiple Group 1 races last season, but over a trip short of her optimum, and on ground probably faster than ideal, it might be worth taking her on with CHAIN OF DAISIES. Henry Candy's mare is currently one from one at the track, she will love forecast rattling quick conditions and signed off last season with an impressive all-the-way Listed win at Newmarket. Turret Rocks is likely to step forward from her comeback effort at Naas.
