**ATR VERDICT:** THECLOCKISTICKING had some very solid novice hurdle form throughout last season and ended a fine campaign with a second behind Diese Des Bieffes at Cheltenham last month when benefiting from a return to good ground. That form, along with his efforts behind the likes of Vinndication and Claimantakinforan, read very well so a handicap mark of 138 looks an attractive one. Stamp Your Feet may benefit from a return to a flatter track having been pulled up at Sandown last time and has a good piece of form at this track having placed behind Bags Groove here in October. Massini's Trap was third on that occasion and has a solid course record with this surface likely to suit more than soft ground here at the Grand National meeting last month.
