ATR VERDICT: EQTIDAAR showed the promise of his maiden win at Nottingham when runner-up to Invincible Army in the Pavilion Stakes at Ascot earlier this month and Sir Michael Stoute's colt is expected to take a step forward. Murillo did his job well for stable companion Saxon Warrior in the 2000 Guineas when shaping as though a return to sprinting would be ideal. Shabaaby was disappointing on his last start as a juvenile but is capable of making a mark in this grade, while Juliet Capulet is an interesting contender dropping in trip.
