That said, he will need to be to defeat the likes of Its The Only Way and Marie's Diamond, who both bring strong form to the table, while the step up to 6f should help The Irish Rover, who was staying on well after a slow start at Ascot last time out. Al Shaqab has owned the winner of this race for the last two years and their Almufti is an interesting newcomer. The son of Toronado is closely related to some black-type performers in Italy and he cost connections 120,000gns as a yearling.
