**ATR VERDICT:** HAMEEM, a 500,000-euro yearling, has let down favourite-backers on both of her starts so far but there was plenty of encouragement to take from her recent performance when just touched off at Lingfield, and John Gosden has put her in the Ribblesdale. Phantasmic stepped forward from her sole juvenile effort to hit the crossbar at Wolverhampton, although the winner didn't do a massive amount for the form in the Lingfield Oaks Trial. Outlane and Snax are bred to improve with age, and the debutant Turaya should also be most effective given a test of stamina.
