ATR VERDICT: Aspen Belle was an impressive winner at Cork a couple of weeks ago but the ground today is unlikely to be as soft as it was on that occasion and a 7lb rise in the ratings will make this test tougher. With that in mind, preference is for KEEP BELIEVING, who bounced back to form when finishing second in a 30-runner handicap at the Curragh recently and he remains on a workable mark based on his 2017 form. Others to consider are Gentil J, Geological and Thiswaycadeaux.
