ATR VERDICT: MYSTIC SKY looked to need the outing in better company than this at Sandown last month and can put that fitness-boosting contest to good use now with his sights lowered. A mark of 123 leaves connections with something to work with, while Maxime Tissier's 5lb claim also helps matters. Level Of Intensity and Eskendash both won class 4 events last time out but deserve to take their chances here, while Mister Universum is respected for the in-form Skelton operation.
