ATR VERDICT: This has been the plan for SAN BENEDETO since he finished second in the Grade 1 Celebration Chase at Sandown last month, and Paul Nicholls' seven-year-old can give weight and a beating to this field. That three-and-a-quarter length defeat to Altior certainly rates as impressive form, even if he was slightly flattered by that proximity to the winner, but he can still show his class here. Capitoul did it well for Dr Richard Newland at Huntingdon last time, while Kapstadt represents a team going well at present under both codes.
