**ATR VERDICT:** Richard Hannon, junior and senior, have a cracking record in this race (winning five of the last 10 renewals) and it may to side with the former's once-raced BALATA BAY. He shaped as if the experience would do him plenty of good when sixth on debut at Wolverhampton and don't be surprised if he takes a big leap forward. Axel Jacklin and Steeve have some solid form in the book and both are respected, while Dutch Treat might be worth a second look in the betting market ahead of her introduction for a powerful team.
