**ATR VERDICT:** A trio of horses at the top of the handicap bid to go one better than on recent runner-up finishes. Settle Petal was beaten the furthest when just under two lengths behind at Brighton, while Tiar Na Nog missed out by half a length over C&D and Kath's Legacy was only beaten a neck at Brighton. They may all end up playing minor roles behind RIVERS OF ASIA, though, as Martin Smith's Guernsey winner shaped as though a longer trip would suit when fourth over a mile at Brighton last time.
