**ATR VERDICT:** Rhododendron put in a brave performance to land the Lockinge at Newbury four weeks ago and deserves her place at the top of the betting here, while the reopposing runner-up Lightning Spear seems to go best fresh and might not prove capable of running to that standard once more. Recoletos is unproven on fast ground, while Benbatl has a bit to prove at this level outside of Meydan. This event went to the USA in 2016, and YOSHIDA looks sure to go well at this level for Bill Mott. He has won his last two on American soil, including a Grade 1 at Churchill Downs last time, and looks poised to relish conditions under Jose Ortiz.
