ATR VERDICT: American raider SHANG SHANG SHANG returned a comfortable winner on debut at Keeneland in April and commands the utmost respect for Wes Ward, who won this contest in 2013 with No Nay Never and has a fine record with his juveniles at this meeting in general. The pick of the home challenge may be Clive Cox's Konchek, who was hampered at the start at Sandown in Listed company last time but was still only beaten by half a length behind Vintage Brut in third. Kinks finished further back in sixth in the aforementioned dash at Sandown but endured a troubled passage and is thus another who could feasibly take closer order this afternoon.
