ATR VERDICT: A very competitive renewal of this contest but the one who gets the nod is KEY VICTORY, who arrives here on the back of an encouraging run in the Prix du Jockey Club. He should benefit from that experience, given that it was just his third career start, and his previous Listed victory suggested that he should be more than capable of winning at this level. Hunting Horn finished in front of the selection in France but he may struggle to confirm that form today and it appears that he could be at his best over further than this trip. One to consider at a bigger price is Stephenson's Rocket, who is certainly talented but he has proven to be a tricky ride in the past. The son of Teofilo was behind the selection over this trip two starts ago but he pulled extremely hard on that occasion and he was far from disgraced when finishing fifth behind Without Parole over 1m in the Heron Stakes last month. The last effort suggested that the return to 1m2f is a positive if he can settle early on and the booking of Jamie Spencer catches the eye.
