ATR VERDICT: Nicholas T ran on strongly to take second over 10 furlongs at Redcar, but is obviously effective over a mile as he landed this prize last year. Balestra has won back-to-back races over 7f of late but is also a winning miler, while Masham Star has form over this trip and went close over 7f here in May. However, it could be worth taking a chance on JAY KAY, who is entitled to come on for his reappearance at Leicester and has won six times at this track.
